Amal and George Clooney

International Power Couple

Amal and George, are one of the most beloved couples on the planet. Everyone has great admiration and respect for them both. We cannot forget one of the most beautiful Wedding in the history of Venice Italy, on the Grand Canal. I will never forget, her beautiful Hand-Appliqued Oscar de la Renta, Wedding Gown, his last, and her Red Cocktail Dress for the After Party. She was stunning! The Three-day star-studded affair floating down the Grand Canal in decorated white boats, while drinking George Clooney's own brand of Tequila, Casamigos, must have been magical, enough memories for a lifetime. He said once "I am proud to be her husband." Amal is beautiful, brilliant and fascinating. George is a very happy man. I am glad they found each other. It couldn't have happened to nicer people.

Amal Clooney is a British-Lebanese lawyer, activist, and author. She has three siblings one sister and two half-brothers. She is a barrister at Doughty Street Chambers, specializing in International Law and Human Rights. Her clients include Julian Assange, the founder of WikiLeaks, in his fight against extradition. Amal also represented the former prime minister of Ukraine, Yulia Tymoshenko. Amal represented Canadian Al Jazeera English journalist Mohamed Fahmy. Who, along with other journalists, was being held in Egypt. He was eventually sentenced to three years in prison and lost a retrial before finally being pardoned by Egyptian president Abdel Fattah al-Sisi.

Amal graduated with a BA degree in Jurisprudence (Oxford's equivalent to the LLB) from St. Hugh's College, Oxford. In 2001, she entered New York University School of Law to study for the LLM degree, where she was a clerk for the clerkship program at the International Court of Justice. She received the Jack J. Katz Memorial Award for excellence in Entertainment Law. For one semester while at NYU, she worked as a student law clerk at the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit in the offices of Sonia Sotomayor, who is now on the Supreme Court of the United States.

Amal, worked at Sullivan & Cromwell in New York City for three years as part of the Criminal Defense and Investigations Group, where her clients included Enron and Arthur Andersen.

Amal completed a judicial clerkship at the International Criminal Court Justice. She clerked under Judge Vladden S. Vereshchetin from Russia, Judge Nabil Elaraby from Egypt, and ad hoc Judge Sir Franklin Berman from the United Kingdom.

Amal was subsequently based in The Hague working in the Office of Prosecutor at the UN Special Tribunal for Lebanon and at the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia.

Amal, in 2014, became involved in the repatriation of ancient Frek sculptures called Elgin Marbles for the Greek government. The sculptures have been part of the collection of the British Museum since 1816. Later that year, Greece decided to stop legal proceedings to recover the sculptures.

In 2014, Amal was signatory of UNICEF UK and Jemima Khan's open letter that urged on the public a call for "action from UK Government to protect women and children." The Office of the UK Attorney General appointed Amal for the period of 2014 to 2019 to the C Panel of the Public International Law Panel of Counsel.

It was announced in 2015 that Amal would be part of the legal team defending Mohamed Nasheed, former President of the Maldives, in his ongoing arbitrary detention. Nasheed was sentenced to 13 years in jail, following what was characterized as a politically motivated trial. Amnesty International described his sentencing as a "travesty of justice." Prior to visiting the Maldives, the local co-counsel working on the case was stabbed in the head, an indication of the danger and instability in the Country. Amal gave a series of interviews about the UN-condemned trial and imprisonment of Nasheed and put for the efforts to support imposing sanctions on the Maldives. According to The Economist, Amal has "helped strengthen the backing of Britain's prime minister, David Cameron, for the cause of Maldivian democracy.

That same year Amal spoke-for the first time at the United Nations-before the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) to discuss the decision she made in June 2016 to represent Murad as a client in legal action against ISIL commanders. Amal characterized the genocide, rape, and trafficking as a "bureaucracy of evil on an industrial scale" by ISIL, describing a slave market existing both online, on Facebook and in the Mideast that is still active today.

"Amal is someone that I enjoy spending every minute of the day with and I'm very proud to be around, watching the things that she does I admire so greatly. I've always been involved in things other than this business long before I was successful at it, but she's been doing it kind of quietly and unheralded for a long, long period of time."

George Clooney is an American Actor, filmmaker, and activist. He has received three Golden Globe Awards for his work as an actor and two Academy Awards, one for acting and the other for producing. Clooney made his acting debut on television in 1978, and later gained wide recognition in his role as Dr. Doug Ross on the long-running medical drama ER for 5 years, for which he received two Primetime Emmy Award nominations. While working on ER, he began attracting a variety of leading roles in films, including the superhero Batman & Robin and the crime comedy Out of Sight. Clooney's biggest commercial success, was the remake of Ocean's Eleven, the first of what became a trilogy starring Clooney. He made his directorial debut a year later with the biographical spy comedy, Confessions of a Dangerous Mind, and has since directed a historical drama, a sports drama, a political drama, and a war film, The Monuments Men.

Clooney won an Academy Award for Best Supporting Actor for the Middle East thriller Syriana and received the Academy Award for Best Picture for producing the political thriller Argo. He is the only person who has been nominated for an Academy Award in six different categories, Best Picture, Best Actor, Best Supporting Actor, Best Director, Best Original Screenplay and Best Adapted Screenplay.

Clooney was included in Time Magazine, as one of the "Most Influential People in the World". He is also noted for his political activism, and has served as one of the United Nations Messengers of Peace since 2008. His humanitarian work includes his advocacy of finding a resolution for the Darfur conflict, raising funds for the Haiti Earthquake, Armenian Genocide recognition, Tsunami, and 9/11 victims, and creating documentaries such as Sand and Sorrow to raise awareness about international crises. He is also a member of the Council of Foreign Relations.

His mother Nina Bruce was a Beauty Queen and City Council woman. His father, Nick Clooney is a former Anchorman and Game Show Host, at AMC for five years in the late 1990s. Clooney has Irish, German, and English Ancestry.

In 2011 Clooney starred in The Descendants as a husband whose wife has an accident that leaves her in a coma. He earned critical praise for his work, and won the Broadcast Film Critics Association Award for Best Actor and the Golden Globe Award for Best Actor – Motion Picture Drama.

Clooney co-starred with Sandra Bullock in Gravity (2013), a science fiction thriller directed by Alfonso Cuaron. He co-wrote, directed and starred in The Monuments Men, an adaption of the Robert M. Edsel's Book. Clooney also produced August: Osage County (2013), an adaptation of the play of the same name. The film stared Meryl Streep and Julia Roberts. Clooney reunited with Julia Roberts for the Jodie Foster-directed thriller Money Monster.

Clooney supported President Obama's campaigns in the 2008 and 2012 Presidential Elections. He is a supporter of gay rights. In 2003, he opposed the Iraq war, saying "You can't beat your enemy anymore through wars; instead you create an entire generation of people seeking revenge." Clooney endorsed Hillary Clinton for the 2016 Presidential Election.

You don't choose me." USC is very excited Glorya chose them! The gift of untold millions? USC built her dream dance school, with her name on it. Glorya Kaufman International Dance Center, GKIDC.

She tells the story of how she met her husband, Donald Kaufman, a young struggling home builder. They went on a Blind Date set-up by a neighbor. The neighbor would see Glorya and her mother outside in the garden picking flowers. He said "I have a friend I would like to introduce you to. I want to get all the Virgins off the block." Glorya and Donald, met and hit it off so well. They married and had four children. Donald loved to dance. That was all Glorya needed to know. Glorya would dance every night if she could. Glorya loves to watch the dance competitions on television. When you see the billboards that read Kaufman and Broad, Glorya is the "K" in the Corporation. She and Eli Broad's wife Edie, are first cousins. The Dance World now has its own Angel, Glorya Kaufman. USC Kaufman School of Dance, is the first New School to open since 1974 on the USC campus.





Vision Institute

Eye surgery has undergone a renaissance over the past twenty years. Local Beverly Hills eye surgeon Brian Boxer Wachler, MD has been at the forefront of many of these advances. Dr. Brian, as affectionately known by his patients, is also a dedicated family man. He and his wife Selina (an architect) stay very involved with raising their twin daughters, now ten years old. The Boxer Wachler family recently grew by four feet by adopting a rescue dog, Roxy. Dr. Brian also finds time to coach one of his daughter's recreation center basketball team.

LASIK is typically a 5-minute procedure with just a one day recovery.

Cataract surgery has evolved significantly over recent years. You might have cataracts if it has become difficult to drive at night from light being too bright or glare and halos around oncoming car headlights. A cataract is a clouding of your natural lens akin to a film developing on your car windshield. Modern cataract surgery is typically a painless, fifteen minute procedure where the cloudy lens is removed and a clear implant lens is inserted. The major advances have been in the types of implants that have been FDA approved. The most advanced implants are those that correct astigmatism (football shape of the eye) and implants that help you read AND see distance ("bifocal lens implants"). These lens implants cannot be felt once implanted and can dramatically improve vision.

Keratoconus is condition whereby the cornea (outer lens of the eye) bulges out like a hernia and can cause a tremendous amount of distortions especially at night like double and triple vision along with

streaks of light. It occurs in 1 in 500 people. Keratoconus can worsen over time which makes night driving impossible. Dr. Brian invented the Holcomb C3-R procedure thirteen years ago that stops Keratoconus in its tracks along with a 99.3% success rate. The procedure's namesake, Olympic Gold Medalist Steven Holcomb, had his Keratoconus treated by Dr. Brian which later enabled Mr. Holcomb to win Gold at the Vancouver Winter Olympics then double Bronze at the Sochi Winter Olympics. Seventeen years ago Dr. Brian pioneered Intacs inserts for Keratoconus that improve vision. These procedures can prevent the need for a cornea transplant and have done just that for thousands of people.

LASIK is a well-established laser procedure to improve vision of those who wear glasses and contact lenses. This year is the 25 year anniversary of LASIK and Dr. Brian was invited by the Greek professor and inventor of the procedure to speak this past summer in Greece at the commemorative conference. LASIK is typically a 5-minute procedure with just a one day recovery. It can be performed on people starting at age 18 years old, so there is no need to wait until you are older to have it. With modern day LASIK no one has ever gone blind (a common myth) and it is pain-free. Dr. Brian developed the use of large optical zone with the laser to reduce the risk of glare and halos at night and invented Fortified LASIK that is revolutionary as it strengthens the cornea for long-lasting results.

Millions of people, mostly women, suffer from dry eyes especially when they are older. Dr. Brian invented the use of testosterone eyelid cream to treat dry eyes which otherwise is a chronic condition. He based his treatment on Harvard medical school research published 18 years ago. He often combines his testosterone cream with a 12-minute procedure called Lipiflow that cleans out inflamed and clogged eyelid oil glands that is often the source of dry eyes.

Walter Camp A Proud tradition

Walter Camp, is The Father of American football," he first selected an All-America team in 1889. Camp- a former Yale University athlete and football coach- is also credited with developing play from scrimmage, set plays, the numerical assessment of goals and tries and the restriction of play to eleven men per side.

The Walter Camp Football Foundation a New Haven Connecticut-based all-volunteer group -was founded in 1967 to perpetuate the ideals of Camp and to continue the tradition of selecting annually an All-American team.

January of 2017 will be the 50th year honoring the All- Americans on the Yale Campus in New Haven. Members of the first team honored the Inaugural year had a Back Field that included: Quarterback Terry Hanratty (Notre Dame) Leroy Keys (Perdue) Jerry Levias (SMU)and O.J. Simpson (USC).

As part of the weekly festivities some players went on the Tonight Show with Johnny Carson in New York. It was there where a 5'-6 Levi as sat in a chair and his feet didn't quite touch the floor. "I can remember him (Carson) looking at me and saying to me how are you doing Little Fellow."

WC FF also gives out an "Alumni Award" in 2017 it will be All-Century Team member and NFL Hall of Famer Orlando Pace (The Ohio State University) is the recipient of the 2016 Walter Camp "Aiumni Award." He will be recognized at the Awards Dinner January 2017.


The event has been televised on ESPN with Master of Ceremonies being ESPN's John Anderson.







The vision to create 'The Star of The Universe and Beyond' was inspired, designed and executed by Stan Kazanjian, the chief designer of the 100 year old family wholesale jewelry company, Kazanjian Bros. Inc.

That discovery, sometime in the 1950's, along with 6 other rare rough sapphires represented a landmark accomplishment for the founders Harry & James with their newly formed foundation.

The first four sapphires were carved into the busts of Lincoln, Washington, Jefferson, & Eisenhower. After many years on loan to the Smithsonian Institute, they were brought to the oval office at The White House at the request of then President Reagan.

The fifth, 'Star of Queensland,' a beautiful cabochon cut star sapphire, was also exhibited at the Smithsonian Institute & later sold to provide scholarships to the Gemological Institute of America.

The sixth, rough sapphire was cut into what became the 'Star of Jolie', designed by Angelina Jolie to support her charities in Africa. This stone has superseded the Star of Queensland, and is now recognized to be the largest black star sapphire in the world.

Today the Kazanjian Foundation maintains an international presence and is continually seeking acquisitions for charitable endeavors.
